presence of the bloody clothes in her home. She said she did not know to whom they belonged, and she was unable to state what kind of clothing her husband wore last Wednesday.

It developed that Feagle had quarreled with the Bernhards about the boundary line between their farms and that this difference was more serious than a quarrel he admitted having with them about hunting.

The officers declare that Feagle is a little deaf, which discredits his statement that he heard cries of distress at the Bernhard home Wednesday night when he was at his home a half mile away.

Feagle is a hunter and trapper, whose home is a half mile west of the ternhard farm, where Mrs. Emily Bernhard, George Bernhard, her son; T. H. Morgan and James Graves were nurdered. He told conflicting stories egarding his relations with the Bernhard family.
