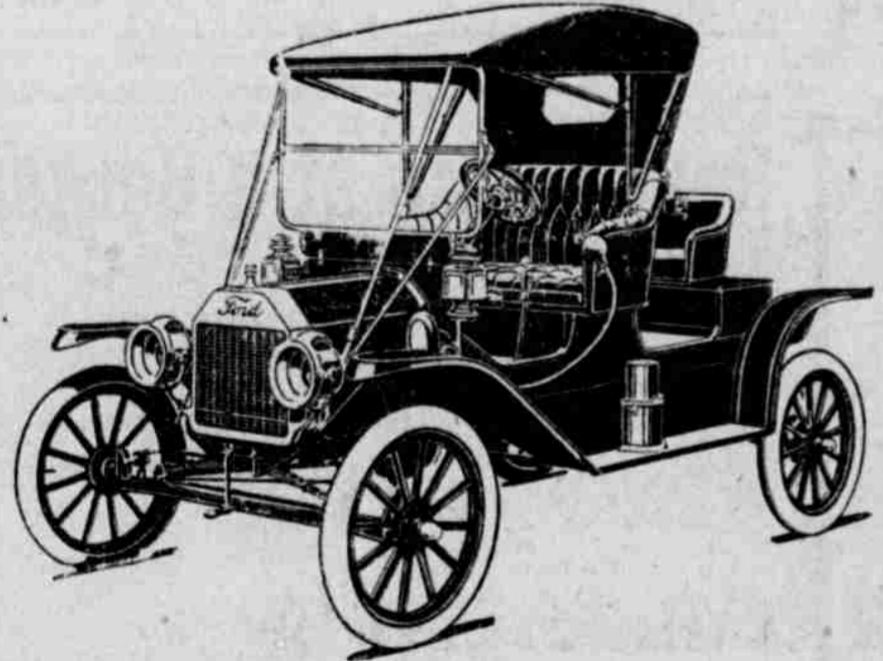

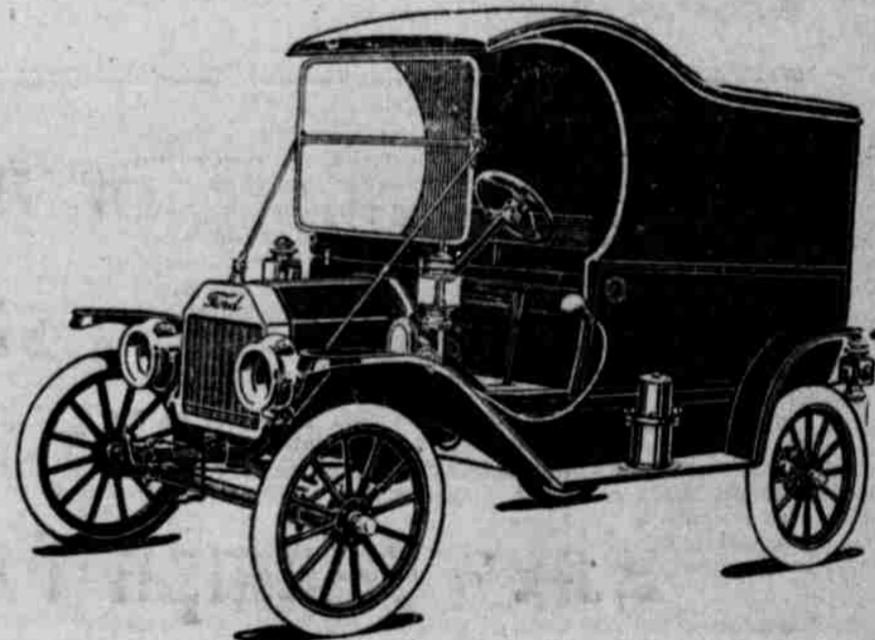

Years Still Continues

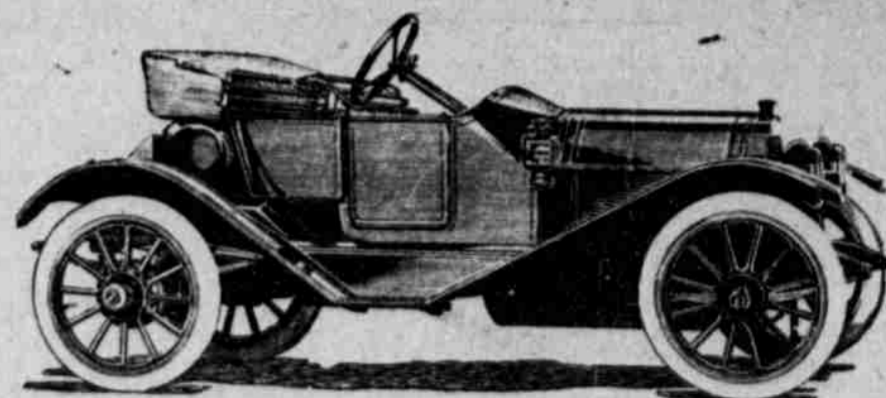
