ORDINANCE NO. 118.

An ordinance providing for the examination and investigation of the condition of houses or buildings within the city of Alliance, Box Butte County, Nebraska, to guard against fire or accident...

Be it ordained by the mayor and council of the city of Alliance, Nebraska: Sec. 6. It shall be the duty of the fire chief of the City of Alliance, Nebraska, as often as directed by the Mayor or Council to enter into any house or building...

Sec. 7. Whenever the fire chief shall give the notice or directions mentioned in the foregoing sections to the owner or occupant of any premises in which any of the matter mentioned in said section shall be contained, it shall be the duty of said owner or occupant...

Sec. 8. The fire chief of the City of Alliance shall have authority to cause chimney burned out or otherwise cleaned whenever he shall deem it necessary, and also forthwith or abate under the direction of the Mayor and City Council, in case of neglect or refusal of the owner or occupant any cause from which immediate danger from fire may be apprehended...

Sec. 9. If any person or persons shall neglect or refuse to comply with any directions given by the fire chief, as provided for in this ordinance, or shall neglect or refuse to cause such removals, better care of management to be made as the said fire chief may direct...

The Chief of the Fire Department shall investigate the cause, origin and circumstances of every fire hereafter occurring in said city. Such investigation shall be begun within two days after the occurrence of such fire...
