The farmers of the west lead all other sections of the country in adopting new and better methods. The rapidly with which southern Idaho farmers are adopting electricity for light and power on the farm has compelled the building of many miles of new transmission lines extending from the central power stations far out into the country districts. Practically 75 miles of additional new lines are now being constructed or will be built for this purpose by one company. This company has approximately 400 miles of high tension lines in southern Idaho, all of which are situated in a progressive, rapidly growing agricultural community.
