155 BORN HERE THE LAST YEAR

Bulletin Number Three, Issued by Nebraska State Board of Health. Gives Births Statistics

155 births were recorded in Box Butte county from December 1, 1912 to December 1, 1913, according to Bulletin Number Three of the Nebraska State Board of Health, just received. 282 sets of twins and 2 sets of triplets were born in the state during the same time. During the same period 97 deaths occurred in Box Butte county and 11,254 in the state. Box Butte county is credited with 91 cases of smallpox, causing 3 deaths; 34 cases of scarlet fever, causing 8 deaths, and 8 cases of diphtheria, with no deaths. 37 divorces were granted in Box Butte county in the period named. 121 marriage licenses were granted. There were 12,373 marriages in the state and 2,020 divorces.
