





The oats germinate and form a solid covering which keeps out the air. A covering of out chaff or cut straw may be put on top of the silage to protect it, or the ears may be removed from the last few loads of corn before cutting and the surface maked with water. All these methods are quite satisfactory. in that they keep out the air and


