The following proposed amendment to the constitution of the State of Nebraska, as hereinafter set forth in full, is submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 3rd, A. D. 1914.

"A Joint Resolution to amend Section six (6) of Article one (1) of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.

Be it Emacted by the People of the State of Nebruska:

Section 1. That Section six (6) of Article one (1) of the Constitution of the State of Nebruska:

Section 5. The right of trial by jury shall remain inviolate; but in all civil cases and in criminal cases less than felonies, five-sixths of the jury may render a verdict and the Legislature may authorize trial by a jury of a less number than twelve men in courts inferior to the district court.
