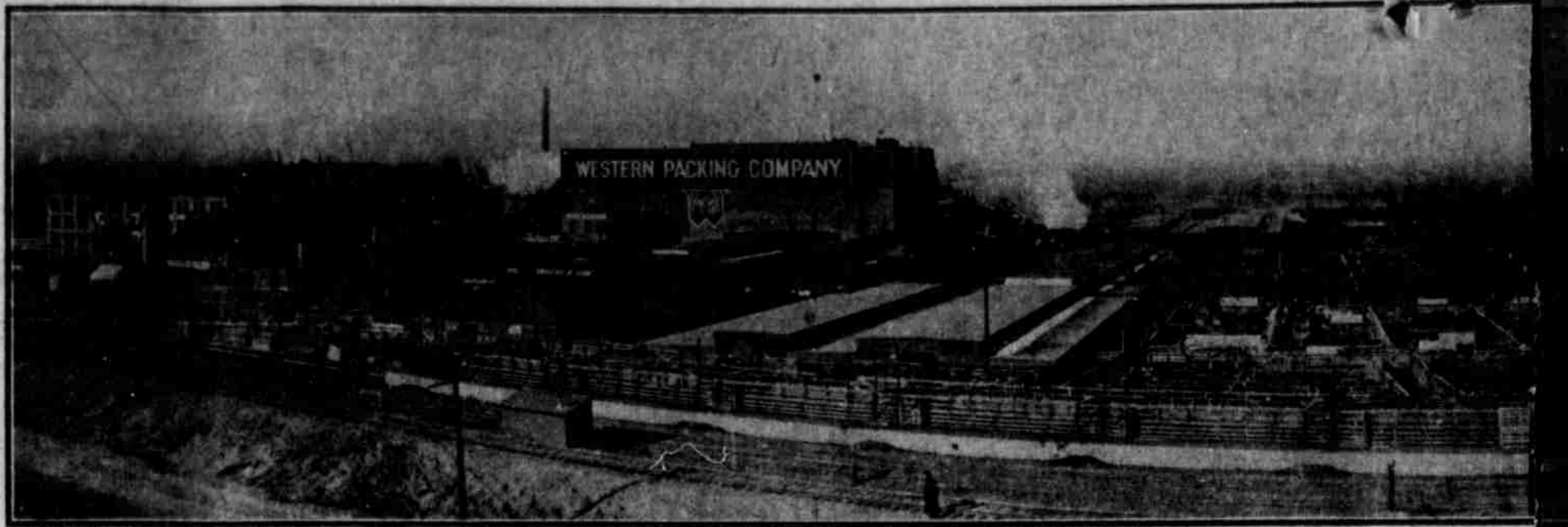


The Rocky Mountain Market

DENVER AS A FEEDER MARKET

Feeder Cattle and Sheep Bought on
This Market Go to Many States
of the Middle West

Denver is the natural market center for that section of the country where are grown the largest number of high-grade feeder cattle and sheep in the world, Colorado, and her inter-mountain neighbors. This statement is confirmed in the awards at the important stock shows held in various parts of the country; at Chicago, Kansas City and Denver. At the last International Show held at Chicago, Colorado and Wyoming cattle carried off practically all the honors in the feeder classes, while the feed lots of the Central West are supplied with sheep from the range territory surrounding the Denver market. There has been a steady increase in the number of feeder sheep bought on the Denver market, and during the past year by far more feeder cattle were received and sold at Denver than in any previous year in the history of the market. The feeder grades of cattle and sheep received at Denver are the best in the world, and successful feeders of live stock have learned from experience to prefer these well-bred, hardy animals to those of any other section of the country.

As a feeder market Denver possesses advantages over any other market and is the best place in the

United States to buy feeder cattle and sheep. The past year feeder cattle and sheep were bought on the Denver market to go to Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, South Dakota, Kansas, Illinois, Missouri, Iowa and Ohio. Buyers at Denver have not only the advantage of broader selection and better quality in offerings, but feeders in a large part of Colorado, Nebraska and Kansas get advantage of through rates on cattle and sheep from point of origin and feeding in transit privileges.

Cattle or sheep bought on the Denver market are received there sound and fresh from the range and will

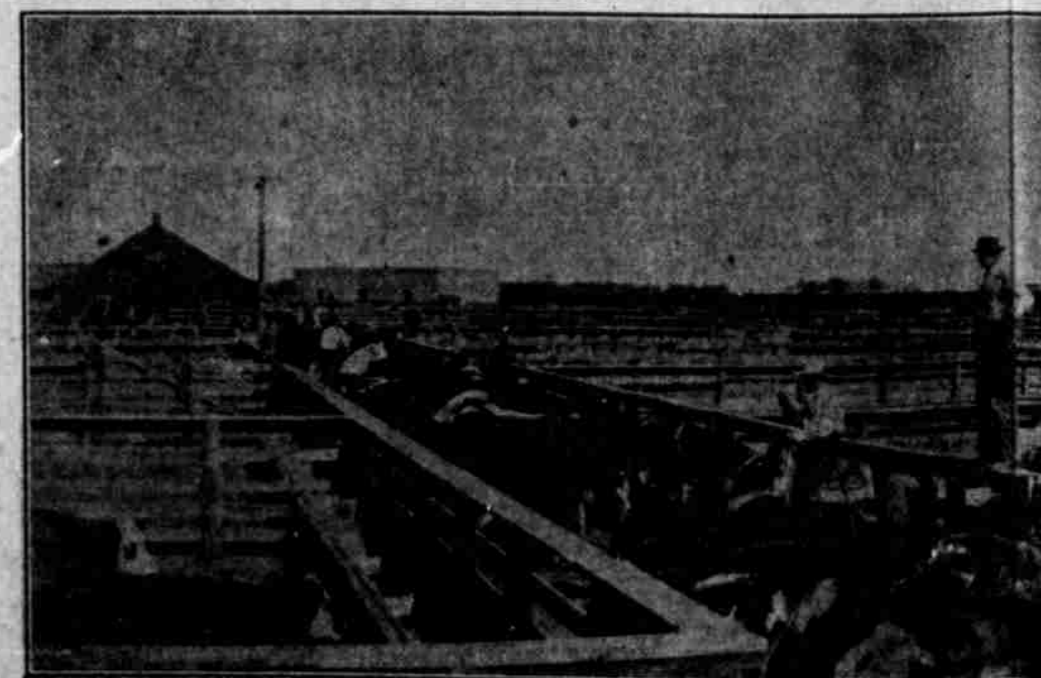
gain from the start. They have not been worked over and "filled" two or three times at feed yards and other markets and are therefore more desirable from the standpoint of the man who wishes to make a profit from his feeding. Cattle and sheep bought at Denver not only look better, but are better and will prove their superiority in the feed-lot.

Though one of the younger markets, Denver has shown the greatest growth recently of any of the western markets and is rapidly gaining prestige as a packing center. Among its packing concerns are represented two of the greatest companies in the world, namely, Swift & Company and Armour & Company, and those interested in the growth and success of the Denver live stock market are to be congratulated on having identified with the market firms of such standing.—The Denver Record-Stockman.
