**ORDINANCE NO. 217**

An ordinance of the City of Alliance providing a method to compel the owners of property in any duly created sewer district in said city of Alliance wherein a system of sewerage has been established to make connections therewith, and providing for notice and assessment of costs for construction.

Section 1. The Mayor and Council of the City of Alliance, Nebraska, may by resolutions passed by the vote of at least three-fourths of the members of said council, compel any owner or owners of property in any duly created Sewer District within the City of Alliance, wherein a system of sewerage has been established and sewer mains laid, to connect their property with said sewer mains, when it shall appear to them that such connections should be made.

Section 2. Upon the passage of the resolution set out in the foregoing section the City Clerk of said City shall notify the owner or owners of the property effected by said resolution, of the passage of same, by either personal service or publication of said notice for a period of not less than thirty days in some newspaper, printed and published and of general circulation within the said City of Alliance, and if such property owners shall fail for thirty days after the completion of the service of said notice upon them to make such connections with the sewerage system and mains, the Mayor and Council shall cause such connections to be made and the costs thereof assessed against the property benefited and upon which said connections have been made; said special tax to be collected as other special assessments.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
