ORDINANCE NO. 295

An Ordinance prohibiting the driving, hauling, operating, or using of traction engines, tractors, trucks, vehicles, or heavy machines having lugs, flanges, or ribs on their tires or wheels, on the Paved Streets of the City of Alliance, Nebraska, and prohibiting the driving, hauling, operating, or using of trucks, traction engines, tractors, vehicles, or heavy machines weighing over 4000 pounds and equipped with iron, metal, steel, or other hard surface material tires or wheels upon the paved streets and alleys of the City of Alliance, Nebraska, and providing a penalty therefor.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive,

haul, operate, transport, or use within the corporate limits of the City of Alliance, Nebraska, upon the paved streets and alleys of said city, any traction engine, tractor, truck, vehicle, or heavy machine having lugs, flanges, or ribs on its tires or wheels: Provided, that where it is necessary, such paved street or alley may be used for travel by such engines, trucks, vehicles, or machines by first laying planks of sufficient strength and thickness thereon to protect the paving from injury, or by removing the lugs, flanges, or ribs from the tires of the wheels of said engines, trucks, vehicles, or machines, and equipping said wheels with a soft material tire.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons in drive, haul, operate, or use upon any paved street or alley in the City of Alliance, Nebraska, any traction engine, tractor, truck, vehicle, or heavy machine weighing more than 4000 pounds and being equipped with iron, steel, metal, or other hard-surface-material tires or wheels.

Section 3. Any person convicted of violating this act shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars and not more than Fifty Dollars for each offense and shall pay all damages done to the highway and the costs of prosecution.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.

ELECTION PROCLAMATION

By the Governor
WHEREAS, a Constitutional Convention called agreeable to law by the people of the State of Nebraska to meet December 2nd, 1919, and whereas the members elected to said Constitutional Convention did so meet and provide that certain proposed amendments to the Constitution be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection, and did further provide that said proposed Constitutional amendments be submitted at a special election to be held throughout the State on Tuesday, the twenty-first day of September, 1920.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Samuel R. McKelvie, Governor of the State of Nebraska, by authority of law in me vested, do hereby direct and proclaim that a special election be held in the several polling places throughout the State of Nebraska on Tuesday, the twenty-first day of September, 1920, during the hours designated by law for holding General Elections for the purpose of adopting or rejecting said proposed amendments.
