PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved February 27th, A. D. 1883, proposing an Amendment to Section Four (4), of Article Three (3), of the Constitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read

and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wil: "Section 4.—The term of office of members of the Legislature shall be two years, and they shall each receive a salary of three hundred dollars for their services during said term, and ten cents for every mile they shall travel in going and returning from the place of meeting of the Legislature, on the mest usual route. *Provided, hoscerce,* that neither members of the Legislature any employees shall receive any pay or perquisites other than their salary and nelleage. *Each* session, *shall* be not less than staty days. After the expiration of forty days of the session po bills be introduced, unless the Governor shall, by special message, call the attention of the Leg-islature to the necessity of passing a law on the subject matter embraced in the message, and the introduction of bills shall be restricted thereto."

The ballots at the election st which said Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the following form : "For proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legislative Department." "Against proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Leg's'ative Department."

Department." WHEREAS, A joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska at the Eighteenth session thereof, and approved February 28th, A. D. 1883, proposing an amend-ment to Section One (1) of Artic'e Five (5) of the constitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-
