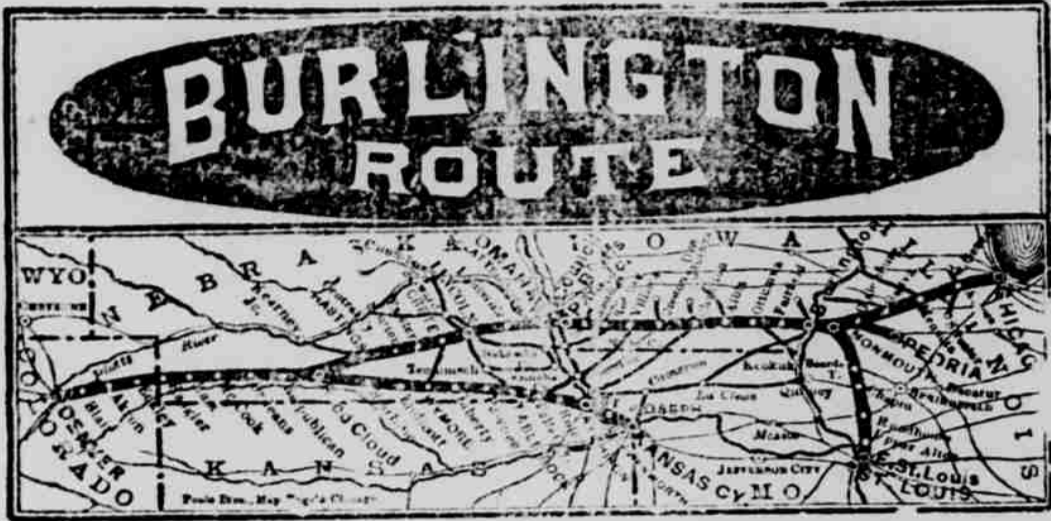

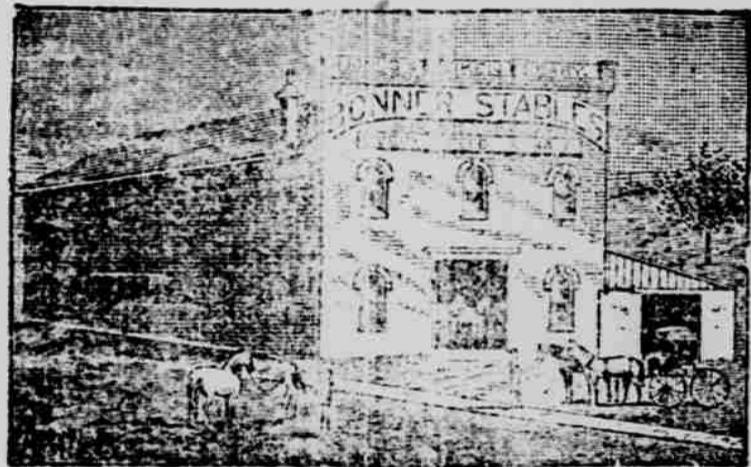

PROCLAMATION.
 WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved February 23d, A. D. 1883, proposing an Amendment to Section Four (4) of Article Three (3) of the Constitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wit:
 "Section 4.—The term of office of members of the Legislature shall be two years, and they shall each receive a salary of three hundred dollars for their services during said term, and no more for every mile they shall travel in going and returning from the place of meeting of the Legislature, on the most usual route, except that neither members of the Legislature nor employees shall receive any other perquisites other than their salary and fees. Each session except special sessions, shall not exceed sixty days. After the expiration of forty days of the session no bill or joint resolutions of the nature of bills shall be introduced, and the session shall, by special message call the attention of the Legislature to the necessity of passing a law on the subject matter contained in the message. The introduction of bills shall be restricted thereto."
 The ballots at the election at which said Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the following form: "For proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legislative Department." "Against proposed Amendment of the Constitution relating to Legislative Department."
 WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska at the Eighteenth session thereof, and approved February 23d, A. D. 1883, proposing an amendment to section one (1) of Article five (5) of the constitution of said state, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wit:
 "Section 1.—The Executive Department shall consist of a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, Treasurer, Superintendent of Public Lands, Attorney General, Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, and Board of Railway Comptrolers. The officers named in this section shall hold their office for the term of two years from the first Tuesday after the first day of January next after their election, and their successors shall be elected and qualified on the 22d day of January. The election shall be held at the same time in each year hereafter. All other officers shall be provided for by law under the provisions of this section, shall be chosen in such manner and shall hold their office for such term of time as may be provided by law, and shall perform such duties and receive such compensation as may be provided for by law. The Governor, secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, Treasurer, Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, and Attorney General shall reside at the seat of government during their terms of office, and keep the public records, books and papers there, and the officers herein named shall perform such duties as may be required by law."
 The ballots at the election at which such Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the following form: "For proposed Amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the Constitution, entitled 'Executive Department.'" "Against proposed Amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the Constitution, entitled 'Executive Department.'" Therefore, I, James W. Dawes, Governor of the State of Nebraska, do hereby give notice, in accordance with Section one (1) of Article fifteen (15) of the Constitution, and the provisions of an act entitled, "An Act to provide the manner of proposing Amendments to the Constitution and submitting the same to the Electors of this State" approved February 13th, A. D. 1877, that said proposed amendments will be submitted to the qualified voters of this State for ratification or rejection at the General Election to be held on the 5th day of November, A. D. 1883.
