

PROCLAMATION.

WHFRFAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved February 27th, A. D. 1883, proposing an Amenament to Section Four 4), of Article Three (3), of the Constitution of said state, and that said section as amended shall read as forlows, to-wit :
