



PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved February 27th, A. D. 1883, proposing an Amendment to Section Four (4), of Article Three (3), of the Constitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wit:

as follows, to-wit:

"Section 4.—The term of office of members of the Legislature shall be two years, and they shall each receive a salary of three hundred dollars for their services during said term, and ten cents for every mile they shall travel in going and returning from the place of a cetting of the Legislature, on the mest usual route. Provided, however, that neither members of the Legislature nor employees shall receive any pay or perquisites other than their salary and a ileage. Each session, except special sessions, shall be not less than sixty days. After the expiration of forty days of the session no bills nor joint resolutions of the nature of bills shall be latroduced, unless the Governor shall, by special message, call the attention of the Legislature to the necessity of passing a law on the subject matter embraced in the message, and the introduction of bills shall be restricted thereto."

WHEREAS, A joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska at the Eighteenth session thereof, and approved February 28th, A. D. 1883, proposing an amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the constitution of said State, and that said ection as amended shall read as follows, to-

"Section 1—The Executive Department
shall consist of a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Andient of Public Accounts. Treasurer, Superintendent of Public
Ins ruction, Attorney General, Commissioner
of Public Lands and Buildings, and Board of
lailway Commissioners. The officers mamed
in this sections a dieach hold his office for the
icrim of two years from the first Thu-rday after
toe first Tue-day in January next after his
election and until his successor is elected and
enalified. Provided, however, that the first
luesday succeeding the first Monday in Novencher, 1886, and each succeeding election
shall be held at the same relative time in each
even year hereafter. All other officers that
may be provided for by law under the provisious of this section, shall be cho en in such
manner and at such times a may be provided by law, and shall perform such dutles
and receive such length of time as may be provided for by law. The Governor, Secretary of
State, Auditor of Public Acc unts Treasurer,
Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings,
and Attorney General, shall reside at the sear
of government during their ferms of office, and
keep the public records, books and papers
there, and the officers herein named shall persuch dutles as may be required by law."
