THE AMERICAN ELEPHANT.

Skeleton of a Monster Recently Found in Missouri.

In writing about a recent discovery, Carl Junken, Mo., a correspondent of St. Louis Globe Democrat, gives highly interesting information. His imagination, he asks, picture a single tusk with a grinding surface of nine inches way and four inches the other? And the face in regular order run twelve to six inches of bone, not solid, but getting in folds, and each fold has its own nervous cavity. The enamel is as white



and smooth as the day, when some mighty food against conviction of nature carried the upper of the tooth down into a depression near Center creek and buried the bone frame under many feet of gravel, clay and mud.

What manner of animal must this have been which had molars like upper and lower millstones? It had tusks. One of these was found near the big teeth measure nine feet in length. It is the longest the animal ever ate is largest. If the tusk of half a dozen elephants could be placed around the country with snows were put together they would not make his equal in the great specimen which is now being held at Carl Junken waiting to be packed in sawdust and shipped to the paleontologist at Washington university. This animal of the great tooth and greater tusks walked on four legs, and ponderous underpinning it was. The ball on which the hind legs moved in the hip socket, is as large as the body of a man. The length of the thighbone can only be proved by proportions. The ball and part of the thighbone have been found, but where the bone tapers midway between thigh and knee there is a brown, porous preserved is the upper bone of the forearm. The first of the joints of the back bone, that on which the head rested, has been found, and so has the rest of the vertebrae—that from which the tail extended. This animal had a foot which was a mass of bones—like the hog's foot. Claws, hair, as long as the goat's, covered it from probovis to tail, and it wandered among glaciers and was glad.

It is said that the paleontologist needs only one small bone from which to reconstruct the whole framework of any animal. From Carl Junken there will be sent, shortly to the scientific men at Washington university several wagon loads of bones to aid them in the restoration of a creature which was from twenty-five to thirty feet long, and which stood from thirteen to eighteen feet high on its bare toes.

While ago the miners near Carl Junken found half digested pine cones, needles far underground, and now they have got the animal that fed upon such course provender. In this day and generation there are no pine trees within forty or fifty miles of Carl Junken. The pine tree took a whole pine tree top for a living. He chewed up chunks of pine wood as large as sections of telegraph poles. As for that purpose he had four of these great teeth on each side of his mouth—two on top and two lower.

Down in the valley of Center creek, in a depression. The earth sinks as if the top of a small cave somewhere underneath had fallen. In such places zinc miners look for "a chimney," as they call it, and for ore. In this depression Mr. S. A. Stuber proceeded to sink a shaft. He went through five feet of rich black soil. Then came clay—a stratum eight feet thick. The next thing was gravel, below which they found the burying ground of the Elephant Americanus.
