EARLY POTATOES. Select For Seed Potatoes That Are Known to Mature Early. In selecting seed potatoes for an early crop we do not trust enough to the potatoes that naturally mature early.

The authority quoted says: "For a potato that can be planted in the soil very early in the season, and that will ripen early and yield a good crop, there is none that surpasses the Early Ohio. This potato has an abundance of good qualities, and its earliness of maturity is not the least."

A Promising New Cabbage. The Succession cabbage depicted in the cut is regarded as one of the most valuable varieties introduced since the Early Summer made its appearance.



The Succession is about one week later than the Early Summer, but is nearly double its size and true to its type under all conditions. It is regarded as a safe variety for the amateur to plant, as it does well at all seasons.

Spring Care of Bees. The bees should be looked after the first warm days that come. Open the hives and see that they have food enough to last until they can gather honey.

Have the new hives with top boxes and frames all ready before other spring work takes up the time. Whether they are allowed to swarm naturally or are divided artificially, it is well to be ready for them in good season.

Onions From Seed. Onions grown to commercial size in the usual way, if set out the next spring, soon enlarge to size fit for table.

Experiment Station Cleanings. Bulletins issued from the agricultural experiment station at Raleigh will be sent to any address in that state on written application to the director, H. B. Battle.

W. H. Caldwell, assistant agriculturist at the Pennsylvania station, has been selected by the American Guernsey Cattle club to take charge of the Guernsey cows entered for the test of dairy breeds at the World's Columbian exposition.

A number of the leading tobacco growers of the Connecticut river valley have organized as the Valley Tobacco Experiment association. Their object is to experiment in fertilizers and methods of growing tobacco in connection with the government experiment station at the state agricultural college.

At the North Dakota station E. S. Keene has been appointed agricultural engineer with a view to having investigations of farm machinery conducted at the station. The first work will be on a stubble burner for removing all straw from the soil after harvesting, thus doing away with the necessity of annual plowing for wheat.

From the Arkansas station comes the report of successful experiments with wheat, oats, grasses and clover at Newport and Pine Bluff, localities in which cotton is now the chief crop.

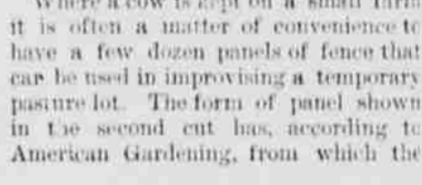
FENCES IN THE GARDEN.

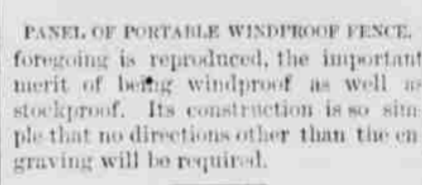

Where a cow is kept on a small farm it is often a matter of convenience to have a few dozen panels of fence that can be used in improvising a temporary pasture lot.



The Indian Games. The Indian games, a thoroughbred variety of fowls that has gained popularity during the past two years in this country, are largely bred in England and differ somewhat from the other games.



In England the Indian game is ranked along with the Dorking for the dressed poultry market. It is claimed by American breeders that this breed grows rapidly, and the body of the fowl, being plump and round, is adapted for the table. It is also claimed that for crossing on common hens, to produce table poultry, the Indian game has no equal.

Essentials In Corn Culture. A speaker at an Iowa meeting of farmers remarked that there are four essentials to the production of first class corn—proper preparation of the soil, good seed, uniform distribution and thorough cultivation.

The objection to drill cultivation of corn ought not to be considered, now that improved tools exist for tending it. In hill culture there can be no uniformity of cultivation as regards time between plowings, while with drilled corn all can be treated alike.
