Jury Receives Case at 4 o'clock Thursday and Returns With Verdict at 9:15.

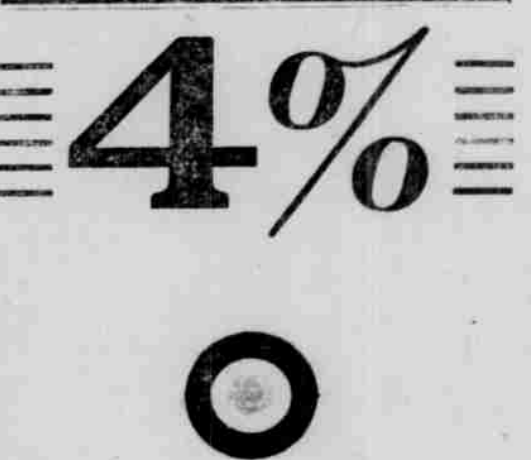
