COURT PRACTICES SCORED

Chicago, May 28.—A young law student, an observer for the Chicago crime commission, who differed with Shakespeare's "Portia" regarding mercy tempering justice, today testified against the court practices of Judge Emanuel Eller of the superior bench. Judge Eller is one of three jurists the commission wants removed from criminal to civil work. That was the crux of "patting with crime." Morton Anderson, the observer, said Eller had granted leniency to a fifty-nine year old woman, "who had spent ten years in the penitentiary." James Hamilton Lewis, former United States senator, counsel for Eller, explained that the woman blamed liquor for her trouble. "Now," and Lewis' voice reached the oratorical pitch of his senate days, "I ask you as a young man about to enter law, as one who perhaps may sit on a bench—and I hope you will—what would your action be in a case like that?" "Sympathy is not supposed to play any part in the operation of justice," Anderson replied. The commission claims the three judges waived felonies, permitting confessed culprits to get off with misdemeanor penalties.

TO CARRY FISH CASE UP

The state will take an appeal in the case of William Miller against Secretary McLaughlin of the state agricultural department and State Game Warden O'Connell in which Judge Wheeler held that the state could not prohibit the use of traps and seines in the Missouri river. This ruling was based on the ground that the state of Nebraska and the state of Iowa have concurrent jurisdiction over the stream and that Nebraska could not prohibit the use of seines and traps when Iowa permitted it. Assistant Attorney General Ayres said that the state wants to make a test case of it in order to determine whether the state does not have jurisdiction over the stream on the Nebraska side. The boundary line is in the center of the stream. Wisconsin and Iowa have held that the state does have such jurisdiction but the federal court has ruled in an Oregon case that the states on each side have concurrent jurisdiction and cannot pass laws that conflict in regard to fishing.
