

County Board Lets Contract for Annual Audit

Evans Audit Company, of Norfolk, Low Bidders—Defer Action on Road to December 3rd.

November sessions of the County commissioners, held on the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th, were largely devoted to the allowance of claim bills.

One matter of business that took considerable time was the hearing of petition, both for and against the establishment of a new road in Section 12, Township 11, Range 13, leading to the Young cemetery. After the hearing, held on November 6, the board deferred final action to permit of further inspection of the territory, until 3 o'clock p. m., Tuesday, December 3rd, the opening day of the December board meetings.

Two sealed bids were filed with the board for an audit of the county offices for the year 1935, the bidders being Evans Audit Company, of Norfolk, \$215, and Robert J. Allison, of Omaha, \$225. The board accepted the low bid of the Evans company.

Order of County Judge revoking Mother's Pension of Rebecca Logan, was approved.

Similar orders by County Judge renewing Mother's Pension of Mrs. Maggie Herrington, Edna Smith, Vera Lancaster and Thelma Nichols were approved.

A claim of Len Austin for \$4.25 for watching the Thomas household goods, filed November 1, 1935, was disallowed.
