**Cut in General
Farm Rate by
Power Company**

Iowa-Nebraska Company Makes An-
nouncement of Proposed Change
Effective January 1st.

The Iowa-Nebraska Light & Power Co. has notified the railway commission that it would put into effect for all-rural customers on Jan. 1 next the added use rate that it has been offering new farm patrons since June 1. The rate will be \$4.50 minimum charge per month, which includes 50 kilowatts; the next 50 will be billed at 4 cents, the next 100 at 3 cents and all in excess of that 2 cents per kilowatt. Commissioner Bollen had objected to the lower rate being applied only to new patrons, and had argued that an increase in farm consumption generally should be made more attractive.

The present general farm rate is \$3.87 1/2, with 6 kilowatts free, as the monthly minimum; next 19 kilowatts 7 1/2 cents per kilowatt; next 25, 5 cents and all over 50 kilowatts, 3 cents. This makes a total of \$6.55 for 50 kilowatts.

Last June Iowa-Nebraska put into effect the added use rate, in the hope of obtaining a greater number of patrons at no increased cost. This was not justified by conditions or by decreased costs, but was made as an inducement to the greater usage necessary if rate reductions are to follow. These rates have not earned an interest on the investment in farm lines, and company officials say they never will unless increased use follows. They are hopeful this will result.

At the time it was hoped to make this rate general as soon as increased use made it possible. Many farmers have increased their use, new lines have been built and new connections made. While the desired increase has not developed, some progress has been made. Commissioner Bollen said the rate represents a very generous reduction, and what he believes to be a proper rate.

SAYS HE WAS KICKED, SUES

Omaha.—John Eggers, 52, farmer living near Elkhorn, filed suit in district court here asking \$10,000 damages from John Schult, Elkhorn, for injuries Eggers said he received in a post election fight Sunday, Nov. 8. Schult lost to Burt Fallon, Elkhorn, a "write-in" candidate for road overseer, in the election. Schult ran for re-election. Eggers says Schult accused him of being Fallon's manager, attacked him when they met on the street in Elkhorn, knocked him down, then kicked him. His injuries caused insomnia and loss of appetite, he says.
