"The free list bill is designed to placate farmers for agricultural losses which they will sustain under the Canadian agreement, but it contains also foodstuffs and boots and shoes. The ifst is as follows: Plows, harrows, headers, harvesters, reapers, agricultural drills and planters mowers, horse rakes, cultivators, wreshing machines, cotton gins, farm agricultural implements all other repair parts.

Bagging for cotton, gunny cloth and fabrics suitable for baling cot ton, burlaps and bags for sacking agricultural products; hoop or band iron or steel for baling cotton; wire for baling hay, straw and other agricultural products; grain leather, buff, split, rough or sole leather bend or belting leather, boots and shoes, harness, saddles and saddlery

Under section 718 of the PayneAldrich law these cabinet woodsbox, cedar, ebony, granadilla, lance wood, lignum vitae, mahogany, rose and satinwood, and all other cabinet woods-are admitted free of duty when brought into the country in the log, rough or hewn only. The value of these woods admitted free during the fiscal year 1910 was $\$ 4,984$,
