CIRCULAR LETTER. STATE OF NEBRASKA, EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, LINCOLN, Jan. 16th, 1874.

To the Commissioners of Cass County Nebraska: Permit me to call your attention, especially, to the First Section of an act, entitled, "An act to provide for the enumeration of the population, and registration of the births and deaths, in the State of Nebraska," approved February 12th, 1867—Chapter 7, "Census," page 201, General Statutes of Nebraska. I suggest that the provisions of this act relating to a careful enumeration of the total number of persons residing in the several precincts of your county be promptly and carefully complied with. Hereafter, I understand, but little, if any, attention has been paid to this act. With our rapidly increasing and increasing population, the question of Congressional representation is an important one, and in which the people are manifesting a lively interest.

The state of Nebraska is without its just and legitimate representation in Congress, and no effort or duty should be left unperformed to secure our due in this respect. It is believed that, with a satisfactory showing of our acts, and a faithful representation of our additional representatives in Congress can be obtained.

It is important that the census should be FULL and ACCURATE, to accomplish the object sought and desired.
