OUR GREENWOOD LETTER.
ED. HERALD:—Sir—Thinking you and the many readers of the Proclaimers of Cass County would like to know how the Queen City of western Cass is progressing, has been the means of inducing us to drive the quill for a few moments.

To those who have never seen our beautiful town, we would say that Greenwood is charmingly situated on the banks of the romantic Saline river, known in vulgar parlance as Salt Creek. This is a splendid agricultural and manufacturing town, and it is not far distant when Greenwood will rank first among the cities of the great West. The town does not exist that we believe better agricultural surroundings than this town does, and herein lies the secret of its greatness. There are two extensive dry goods and grocery stores here one under the management of W. Ethelredge & Son, who are doing a splendid business. Mr. Ethelredge formerly resided in Plattsmouth, but some six years ago, recognizing the fact that Greenwood would some day make a fine town, he wisely settled on a piece of land about one and a half miles from Greenwood, and about four months ago he bought out the stock of Geo. Hinkley, the other store in town. By the time he had secured the store, he was well known and respected to require further notice here. We have also two resident physicians, Dr. H.
