An ordinance providing for the 'es ablishment of Water Rates to Consuners connected with the water system of the City of Red Cloud, Nebraska and repealing Section 19 of Ordinance No.39 of the revised Ordinances of the city of Red Clond, Nebraska adopted Jan. 12, 1914.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Red Cloud, Nebraska

Section 1. For all Consumers of water using meters the following rates shall apply, each bill being computed upon the basis of a fixed charge depending upon the capacity of the meter and a per thousand charge depending upon the actual amount of water used. Per quarter Per thousand enpacity charge gal charge 25 cents 24.5 cents

Section 2. That Section 19 Ordinance No. 39 of the Revised and Compiled Ordinances of the City of Red Cloud, adopted Jan. 12, 1914 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption, approval and publication according to law. Adopted April 29, 1918.


