### Landis' Successor Former Nebraskan

Hastings, Neb., July 13.—James H. Wilkerson of Chicago, who has been nominated by President Harding to succeed Judge K. M. Landis as fed-

eral judge, was principal of Hastings High school in 1889 and 1890. He left here to accept a professorship at Depauw university, and while there studied law and was graduated. Judge Wilkerson was interested especially in civics and federal matters while in Hastings. To promote the study of civics in the high school, he organized the student body into a
