

1,500 Baskets to Be Given Needy Families

Approximately 1,500 baskets will be distributed to the needy and destitute families of Omaha today by the Salvation Army, Volunteers of America, Associated Charities, American Legion, Disabled Veterans of the World War, War Mothers, Women's Ex-Servicemen League, and City Mission.

"If anyone is without food this year," said Mrs. George W. Doane, secretary of the Associated Charities, "it will not be our fault for we are assisting everyone. The spirit of giving is very high this year."

The average cost of a basket of food given by the various organizations is \$5, while the Volunteer of America baskets cost about \$8, according to Miss Alice McCormick of the Volunteer headquarters.
