

Walking Erect.

To maintain an erect position, or to recover it when lost, in a manner which is at once natural, easy, and efficient, it is only necessary to walk habitually with the eyes fixed on an object ahead a little higher than your own-the top of a man's hat, for example-or simply keep the chin a little above a horizontal line. If either of these things is done, the necessary, easy, and legitimate effect is to relieve the chest from pressure, the air gets in more easily, develops it more fully, and permeates the lungs more exclusively, causing a more perfect purification of the blood, imparting greater health and more color to the cheek.
