From 3,400 to 4,500 bobbins are required to thread one lace machine, besides the beam and warp, making a total-when the machine is threaded-of 13,000 threads in actual work. When a machine is fully threaded there are 6,700 miles of cotton on it, enough to reach from here to England and nearly back again.

See the illustrations of the various machines in operation-where they take in the thread and turn out the dainty, attractive laces-also skeins of yarns, yarn spools-pieces of lace just as they come from the machines. Especially interesting is the process of clipping, scalloping and separating. The exhibit is so unique and the values so unusual t
