FIRST DAY.

1st Race.—Half-mile and repeat. Free for all. Purse—\$75. First, \$37.50; second, \$22.50; third, \$15.00.

2nd Race.—Half-mile dash. For herry county and Rosebud horses only. Purse \$75.00. First, \$37.50; second, \$22.50; third, \$15.00.

3rd Race—Quarter-mile dash. Free for all. Purse—\$75. First, \$37.50; second, \$22.50; third, \$15.00.

SECOND DAY.

1st Race—One-mile dash. Free for all. Purse—\$100.00. First, \$50.00; second \$30.00; third, \$20.00.

2nd Race.—Half-mile and repeat. Free for all Purse—\$75 00. First, \$37.50; second \$22.50; third, \$15.00.

3d Race.—Quarter-mile dash. For cherry county and Rosebud horses only. Purse - \$50.00. First, \$25.00; second, \$15.00; third, \$10.00.

THIRD DAY.

1st Race.—Quarter-mileldash for ponies. Free for all-141 hands or under. Purse—\$50.00. First, \$25,00; second, \$15.00; third, \$10.00.

2nd Race—One-mile Novelty race. Free for all. Purse—\$125.-00. First quarter, \$12.50; second quarter, \$25.00. third quarter, \$37.50; fourth quarter, \$50.00.

3rd Race.—Consolation Race. Purse—\$50.00. First, \$25.00; second, \$15.00; third, \$10.00. Free for all horses that have started in these races and have not won purses in any race at this meeting. Two or more to start or no race. Entrance free.

Rosebud and Cherry County horses must have been owned on Rosebud Agency or in Cherry County Three months prior to day of race. Entrance 10 per cent. of purse; five to enter and three to start or race will be declared off. Entrance fee will be received at Secretary's office not later than 9 o'clock on each day for races of that day. American Racing Rules to govern.
