Marketing Crops Expensive.

The report of the industrial commission on the distribution of farm products show that the cost of hauling farm products over country roads is estimated at \$900,000,000 a year, or more than the entire cost of operating all the railways in the United States which is placed at \$818,000,000. The average haul to the nearest shipping station is twelve miles, and the average cost is 25 cents per ton per mile or \$3 per ton for the twelve miles.
