BIBLE STUDY IN TIIE UNI-
The Bable study dinner in the $Y$. M. C. A. rooms tonight promises to be an occasion long to be remembered because it marks the initation of the annual Bible Stuay dinuer into the life of the assoclation.
The BIble classes are led either by the members taking turns, or by a leader appointed by the committee having the work in charge. No set program is used but each leader follows his own plan aided by suggestions from the Rible Study committee. This method gives the utmost freedom to informal disenssitons and produces a reeling of sympathy and equality of man to man.
The object or these classes is to firduce a dally and systematic stuay of the Bible. Many colleges and universities have recogoized the fact that no man's education is complete without a knowledge of its teachings and have aecordingly placed it in the curriculum.
The importance of a close acquaintance with the Mole is ton thoroughly recognized by all leading educators for any man to question the valldity of its study, and the young man who goes through the university without having gained a knowledge of its fundamental teachings, will, sooner or later. wake up to the fact that he missed the most important part of his colleke course.

A NEW DEPARTURE IN LEGAL EDUCATION. "A LEGAL CLINIC.
A rather novel departure in the Law School of the University of Pennsylyania has been instituted this year by Assistant Professor Roberts. He calls it a Legal Cifnic or Seminar, for want of some more
exact definition. The Seminar open only to thira year men, and is ilmitea in number to twelve.
The wrork to be taken up this year will be discussion of the cases in the advance Reports of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania. The methor will he to have the history of the case read, then to engage in a general discussion of the procedural features of the case, the nature of the remedy, other remedles avallable, etc. The men will then be asked for opintons upon the points involved in the case and the method of thelr
presentation to an appellate court. A decision on the case will be reached after this conference, and then the opinion of the Supreme Court will be reaa, by some member of the class to see how nearly the judgment formed accords with the result reached by the court. The decision will then be testea in the light of the authorities sited by the court.
The benefits which it is believed will accrue from this work are oi several sorts. In the first place, it will familiarize the men with the various forms of procedure and with the practical side of the presentation a review of all the work that the men a review of all the work that the men
have done throughout their law school course, as the cases will be read Indiseriminately in their order as reported. Further, the dceision of the case by the class, before reading the opinion of the court, will serve to help the men on a sound legal judgment on complicated state ments of fact. It is believed that
the thorough drin in case analysis that will thus be gained cannot fai to be of service in actual work at the bar. Last but not least, it will familiarize the class with the current cases in Pennsylvania and render
them ready in the citation or the late authorities on the points covered by the decisions read.
