A special train will return to Omaha in the evening leaving Lincoln shortly before 6 o'clock.

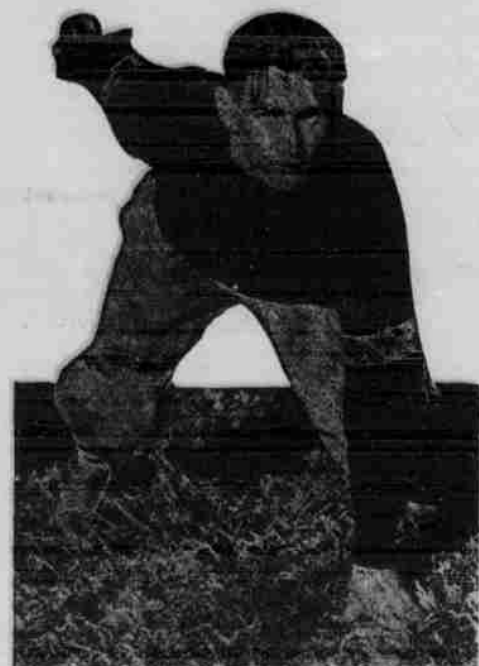

Right half. First year. He demonstrated his ability to lug the ball in the Kansas Aggie game.

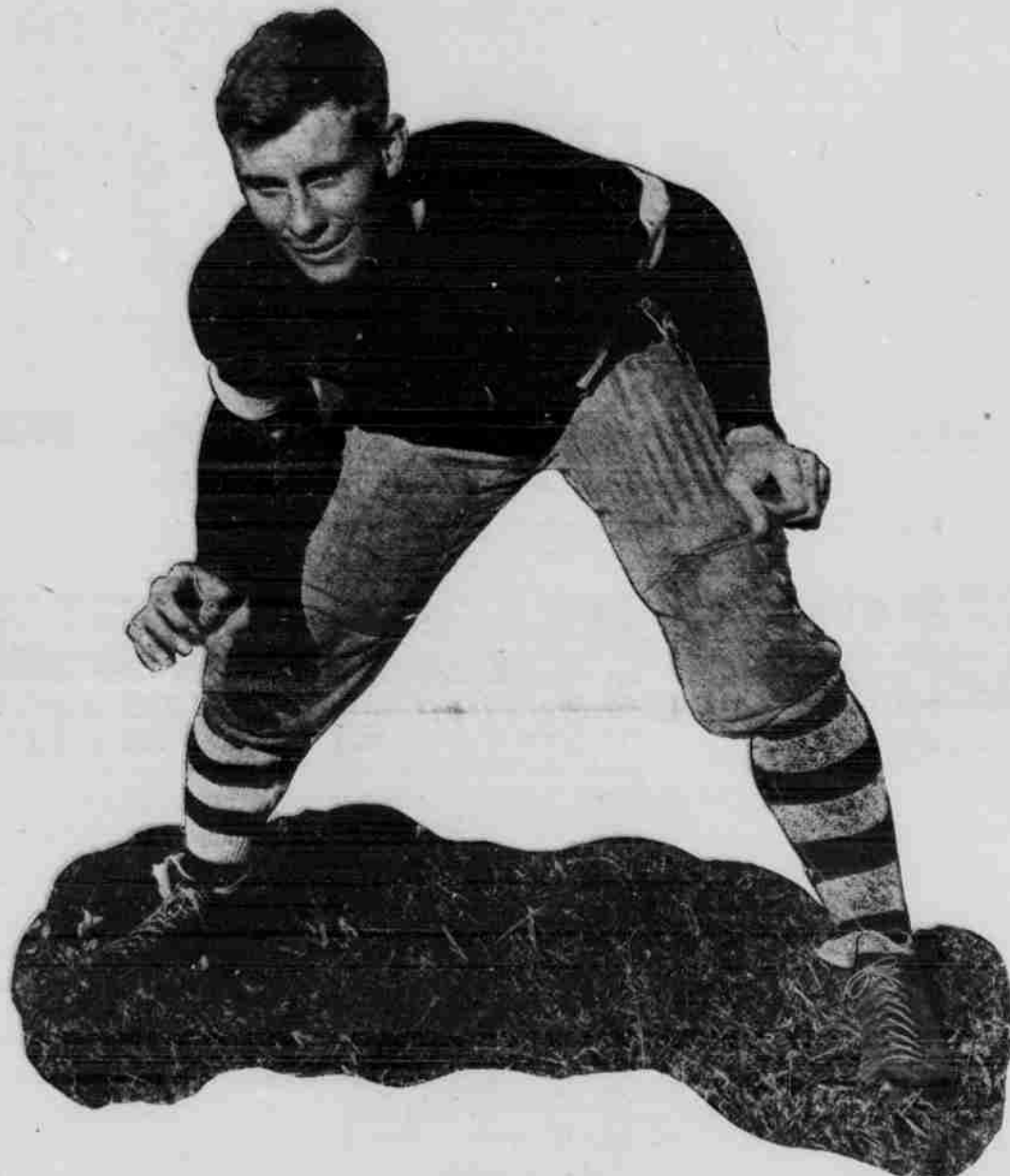

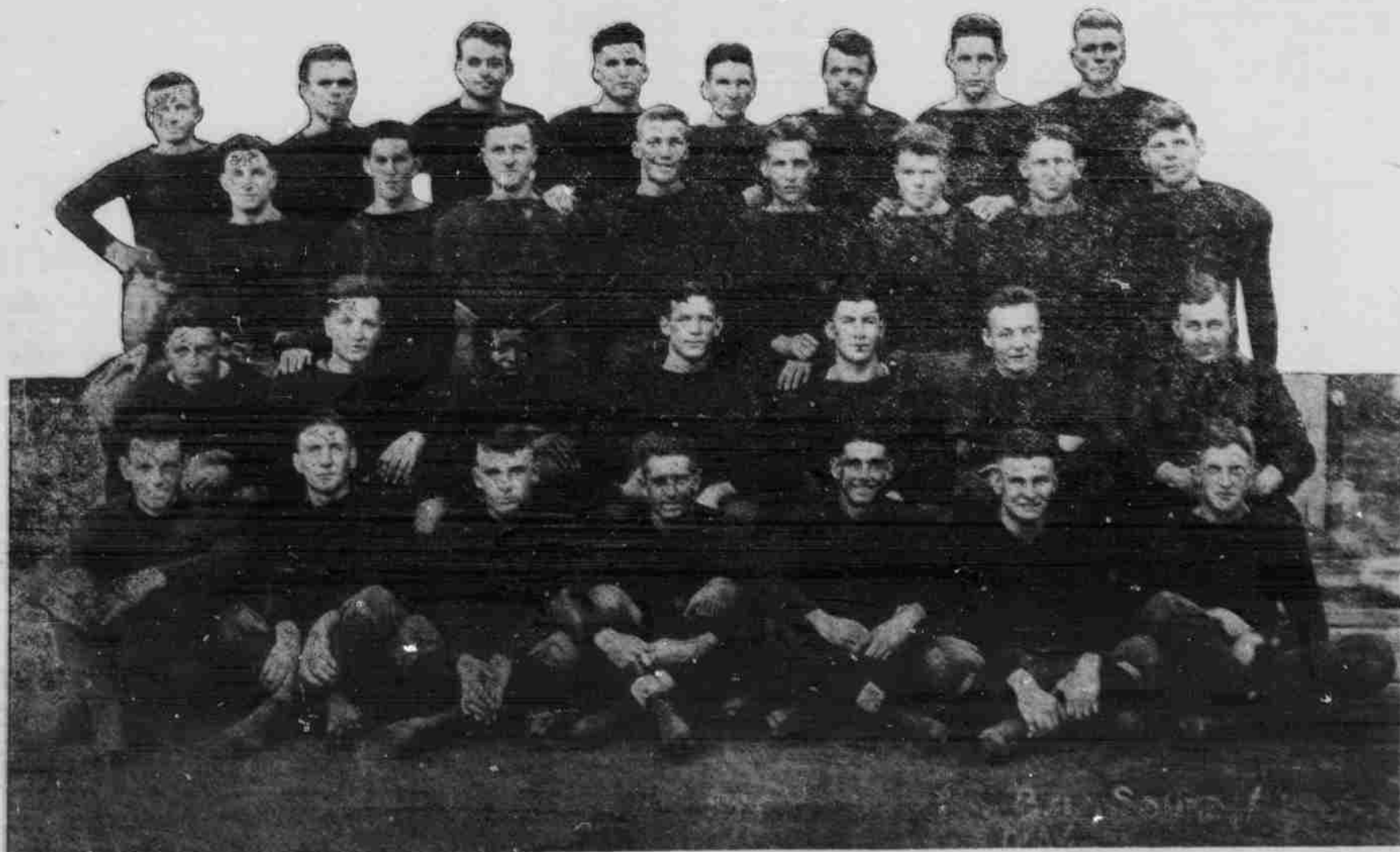
WARREN HOWARD
