Mrs. Adaline A. Thompson has left the list through Japan 1. Persia 1, Turkey 2. close of term. The Rt. Rev. William Lawrence becomes president of the board, and William H. Lincoln, vicepresident. Lewis Kennedy Morse is now treasurer. New appointments to the Board since the last annual issue of the Calendar are Dr. Cyrus H. K. furtis, of Philadelphia, Miss Ruth Sharpless Goodwin, B. A., '98, Alummae trustee, and Eugene V. R. Thayer, of Boston.

Members of the faculty, in service the present year, are thus classified: Professors, 27; associate professors, 32; instructors, 56; assistants, 15; lecturers, 7; purely administrative officers, 39. Only one appointment to the list of professors from without the college has been made for the present year-that of Louis Perdriau, professor of French language and literature. Students are classified as follows: Resident candidates for the M. A. degree, 22; seniors, 282; juniors, 312; sophomores, 311; freshmen, 440; noncandidates for degrees (largely candidates for the certificate of the department of hygiene), 85.
