PROF. LERROSSIGNOL TO SPEAK AT COLORADO COLLEGE

Prof. J. E. LeRossignol, of the department of economics and commerce, will leave soon after school closes for Colorado Springs, Colo. He will give the Phi Beta Kappa address at Colorado college on June 12, his subject being the "Minimum Wage." 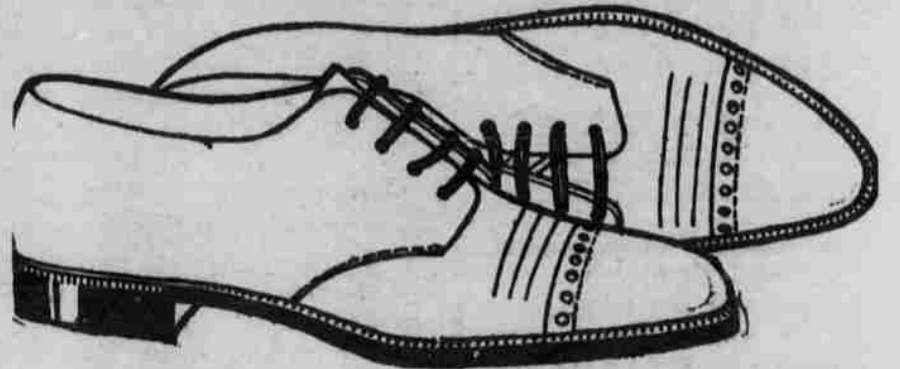
