COUNCIL OF DEFENSE CALLS AT-TENTION TO WHEAT SHORTAGE

it, these are the facts: No wheat if sold for market purposes will bring more than \$2.15 a bushel f. o. b. Omaha. Mills and elevators of Nebraska are under the control of the United States government, and it is impossible for any public buyer to compete with the government, which has made provision to take over the entire wheat crop of 1917 and previous year's stocks now on hand.

Therefore, any farmer who has wheat seed on hand and withholds it ofr a higher price is seriously interfering with his government's effort to obtain as large a planting of wheat this fall as possible, and in the end he will suffer financial loss for so doing.

It is earnestly desired that those who can help in the great task Nebraska is asked to perform will at once heartily co-operate in every way possible, so that no person who is willing to plant wheat this fall shall be prevented because of his inability to obtain the necessary seed supply at an equitable price.—George Coupland, vice-chairman, Nebraska State Council of Defense.
