By the induction method he is going into the service about six months ahead of the time that his regular call would have come. The men going to Fort Logan at this time will probably be kept in detention for a period of about three weeks and then may be assigned to units in the regular army. Fort Logan

is a regular army concentration point. Starboard took his place on The Nebraskan soon after the first semester and handled the news on the State High School Basketball tournament in March.

REGISTRATION DROPS ONE-FIFTH FOR YEAR

Of course, this surplusage of men registered may be offset by this time statistics show that there are 1,740 men registered in the combined colleges this year and only 1,552 women. by the heavy withdrawals of men for war service. The following is a summary of the comparison of last year's and this year's registration by colleges.
