The batting order for today's game as Coach Schissler issued yesterday is as follows:

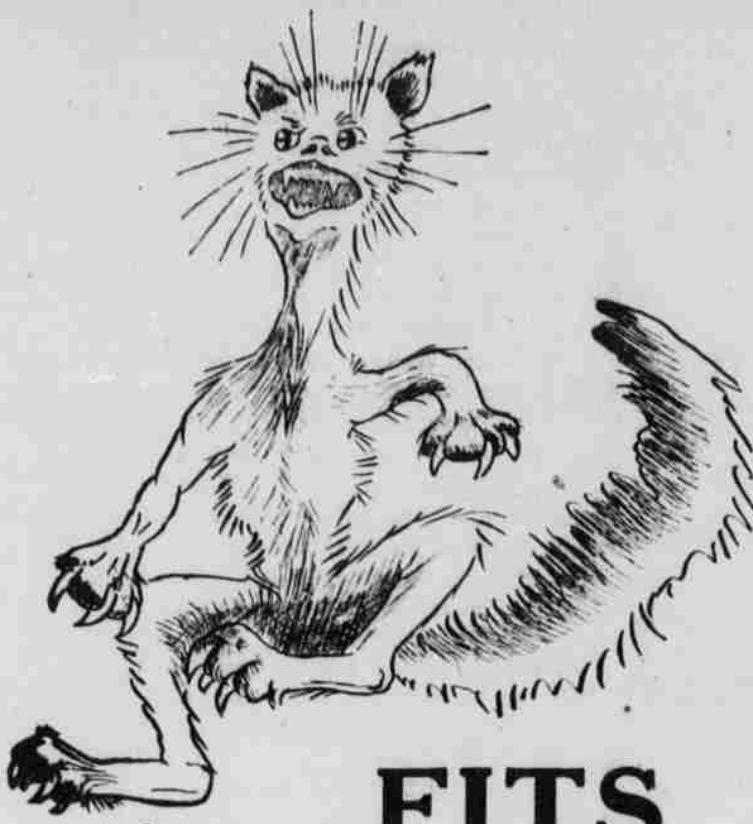
