TEACHERS COLLEGE IS TO BE REORGANIZED

relations with federal agencies at those obtaining in the Smith-Hughes act.

"Candidates for the so-called junior certificate or for the University certificate shall matriculate in the Teachers College throughout their course.

"There shall be no dual matriculation.

"The faculty of any college of the University shall be composed of those persons recommended by the dean to the chancellor and approved by the regents. It is understood that the dean and chancellor will recommend to the regents as members of the faculty of the Teachers College only the following: (1) Those who devote the major portion of their time to instruction, administration, or supervision in the Teachers College; (2) certain selected persons who though carrying duties in other colleges are actively engaged in the work of supervision or administration in the training of teachers, as for instance those engaged in the administration of the Smith-Hughes act.

The enthusiasm over the action of the regents was shown last week when 1,500 teachers gathered at the convention of District No. 1 of the State Teachers association extending congratulations to the chancellor of the University for his action in recommending autonomy for the Teachers College and to the Board of Regents for placing the control and direction of the college under its own faculty.

Hervey F. Smith, state secretary for the county Y. M. C. A. work, has been secured to speak to the class in rural community leadership. Prof. R. O. Rankin, at the regular meeting Wednesday evening, April 6, in room 205 of the Rural Economics building on the Farm campus.
