ore of lower iron content and coke higher in ash can be used; and it is believed that the sulphur content of the iron can be reduced.

Reduce Gas Prices.

Metropolitan gas-users may not always complain of high prices if the possibilities of this research are exhausted. The manufacture of city gas was beyond the scope of these studies as originally outlined; but it was found that gas made with oxygen substituted for air would have a third larger heat-content per cubic foot and could be supplied at a lower cost. Gas generally requires the addition of oil to bring its heating value up to illumination standards, but in the opinion of the committee,

this would not be necessary to gas made "the oxygen way."

Since the cost of metal enters into every phase of construction, the work in which Professor DeBaufre has had a part should bring general benefit in price reduction. Experiments are in process to determine the commercial feasibility of what is determined to be theoretically sound.
