

### DAWSON TO REMAIN HEAD HUSKER COACH

Regents Relieve Athletic Director of Responsibilities as Dean of Men.

At a meeting of the Board of Regents, held in Omaha last week, the resignation of Fred T. Dawson as dean of men was accepted. Mr. Dawson was retained as athletic director and coach of football, with no increase of salary.

Mr. Dawson has been coach of football for the past three years. Two years ago he was elected to fill the position of athletic director, caused by the resignation of Fred W. Luchring. Last year he was selected as dean of men besides his regular duties in the athletic department.

Because of the time and worry the three positions caused, Coach Dawson suffered a nervous breakdown at the close of the past football season.


