**PROF. C. O. WEBBER TALKS ON PSYCHOLOGY**

"Race Psychology" was discussed by Prof. C. O. Webber of the state university Tuesday evening before the psychology-journal club at Nebraska Wesleyan university. "Psychologists aroused a theoretical interest in race psychology long before the subject was taken up in a practical way. Now it is of tremendous importance. The war exemplified racial hate and suspicion.

"Psychology has had a mushroom growth. Delivers into other lines, as botany, history and sociology, have taken up the psychological side of their study. Mob violence is a mark of the age. False opinions of racial psychology have something to do with mobs. The psychologist has to determine whether races are potentially equal or not. The opinion has prevailed that savage races possess keener sensory acuity but psychological tests have indicated that savages are inferior to the whites in sensory acuity. Differences in sensory powers are so small as to be negligible. Complex intellect tests do show differences. Negro and Indian children are inferior to whites but less so than is thought. Negroes are at a disadvantage in abstract thinking but they show little difference in memory. Indians are found to be a little inferior here to the negro. Indians are superior to whites and the negro in fatigue

tests. Perhaps that is due to the fact that the Indian works more slowly and does not so exhaust himself. F. M. Taylor has proved that men work better if they go slowly at first.

"The mulatto is more intelligent than the pure negro. The kind of whites the mix with blacks is inferior. Psychologists know little about temperament. That and devotion to ideals are hard to measure. A number of psychologists are trying to devise means for measuring these capacities of man.

"The Germans are a willing and plodding race. They make good at juiceless tasks like cabinet making.

The Jews take an interest in abstract thought. Einstein is of Jewish extraction. Most of our colonial immigration was Nordic. Beginning with 1840 there was a falling off. Since 1920 the Nordic influx

has almost ceased. At present we get almost 75 per cent of our immigration from southern Europe. This is effecting great changes in our cities and no doubt bringing many criminals to our shores."

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

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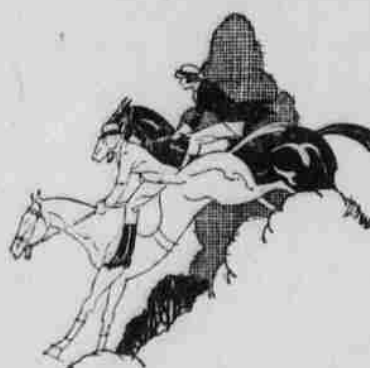
