Teachers College Has More Students

The present enrollment of Teachers College is 1,092 and will exceed 1,100 before registration is complete, according to figures given by Prof. George Rosenlof Wednesday afternoon.

This is an increase of 156 over last year, and 358 more than 1922.

Two-Story Addition Furnishes New Rooms

The Temple has been greatly improved by the addition of a new wing which was completed about September 1. Work was started on the new addition about July 1.

Two brick stories were constructed above the cafeteria, between two of the old wings. The cost of construction was approximately \$12,000, which was low, since three of the walls were already in position and material for the new roof was taken from the old roof, formerly over the cafeteria.

This improvement adds approxi-

mately 3,200 square feet of floor space to the Temple. Two classrooms which will be used by the dramatic arts department, and two offices for the department will occupy the first floor of the addition. The second floor will be composed of two rest-rooms.
