

**CORNHUSKERS LOSE TO OKLAHOMA GRIDSTERS**

yard loss by Collins. Second down, 5 to go. Lamb ripped through Nebraska's right guard for a touchdown. Bristow place kicked the extra point. Score: Oklahoma 14; Nebraska, 0. Kamm went in at quarterback for Bloodgood in the Nebraska backfield. Hendricks kicked off 11 yards, Westoupal recovering, on Nebraska's 39-yard line. A forward pass, Rhodes to Kamm, was incomplete. Myers failed to gain on a fake punt formation. A pass by Kamm was intercepted by Stough on Oklahoma's 39-yard line. Grow went in for Westoupal. Lamb made 1 yard through the line. On the next play, Oklahoma was penalized 15 yards for holding. Ball on Oklahoma's 26-yard line. Stough made 1 yard on a fake punt formation. Lamb punted 15 yards. Nebraska's ball on Oklahoma's 40-yard line. Kamm made 2 yards off Oklahoma's left tackle. Rhodes slipped through tackle for 5 yards. Myers hit the line for 2 yards. Oklahoma was offside and was penalized 5 yards. Bronson went in for Kamm. Hendricks intercepted Bronson's pass on Oklahoma's 30-yard line and the half ended. The half was up with Oklahoma in possession of the ball on their own 20-yard line. Score: Oklahoma, 14; Nebraska, 0.

**Third Quarter.**  
Nebraska started the second half with the same line-up that started the game. Oklahoma's lineup was also the same. Hendricks kicked off 40 yards. Myers returned it 15 yards to Nebraska's 40-yard line. Bloodgood made 2 yards through center. Bloodgood punted 55 yards to Oklahoma's 5-yard line. Bristow ran out of bounds for a half-yard gain. Lamb dropped back of his own goal line and Oklahoma faked a punt. Hendricks failed to gain. Lamb punted 20 yards out of bounds. Nebraska's ball on Oklahoma's 25-yard line. Rhodes made 2 yards through the line.

On a tackle-around play, Ed Weir made 15 yards, putting the ball on Oklahoma's 10-yard line. Bloodgood lost 2 yards trying Oklahoma's left end. Rhodes made 4 yards through the line. Ball on Oklahoma's 8-yard line. On a tackle-around play, Weir fumbled and Bloodgood recovered for no gain. Fourth down and 8 yards to go. Bloodgood passed to Collins for 9 yards and a touchdown. Collins snatched the pass out of an Oklahoma man's hands as it came over his shoulder. Bloodgood place kicked the extra point. Score: Oklahoma, 14; Nebraska, 7. Hendricks kicked off 50 yards to Bloodgood who returned 27 yards to Nebraska's 27-yard line. Man-

dery rining from punt formation made 9 yards through the line. Rhodes was thrown for a 6-yard loss. Lamb punted 33 yards, Rhodes returning 3 yards, placing the ball on Nebraska's 43-yard line. Bloodgood made 5 yards off Oklahoma's left tackle. A pass by Rhodes was intercepted by Bristow on Oklahoma's 44-yard line. Westoupal jumped and stopped Lamb for 5-yard loss. Bristow made 1 yard through center. Lamb made 6 yards through center. Time up for third period. Ball on Oklahoma's 47-yard line. Oklahoma in possession of the ball. Score: Oklahoma, 14; Nebraska, 7.
