**GAIN INFORMATION BY QUESTIONNAIRES**

**Nebraskan to Publish Series of Articles on Results of Investigation.**

Work has begun in compiling the information obtained from the questionnaires recently circulated in all classes at the request of Chancellor Avery. Results will not be complete for at least a week but as soon as they are determined, a series of stories on them will be run in The Daily Nebraskan.

The answers to the questions will furnish a quantity of information about the student body as a whole which will be interesting and valuable, according to the results gained by use of similar questionnaires in other institutions. Data, which will be obtained from them, will be nearly complete judging from the number of questionnaires which were turned in by instructors.

Statistics will be available, after the compilation is completed, on the average amount of money spent by students during a school year, comparative living expenses of men and women, the average number of hours carried by students, the percentage of students who are totally or partially self-supporting, the manner in which students earn the money they expend on their education, and other data of similar nature.

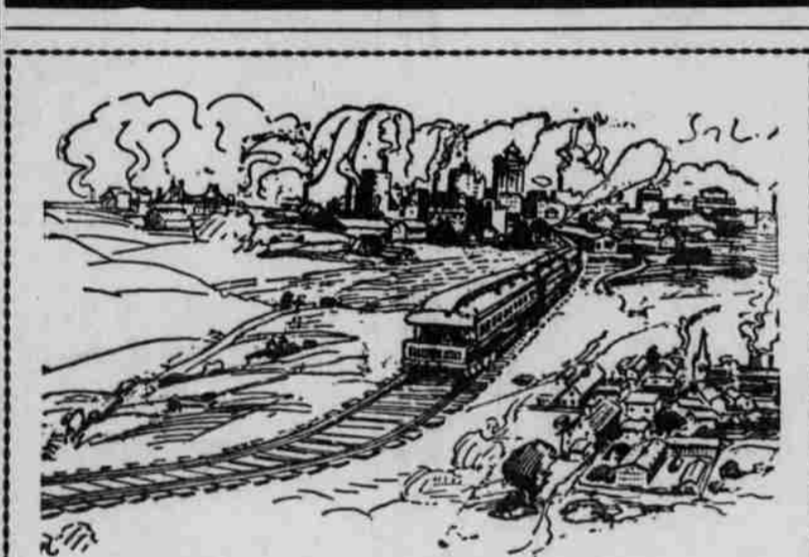
