

ATHLETES WILL RECEIVE AWARD

Gold, Silver, or Bronze Medal Will Be Given to Each Letter Winner

FOB WILL BE LIFE PASS

Wishing to give some token that will be more lasting than the "N" sweaters awarded to players, the athletic department now awards a medal to each letter man. This medal is to be awarded to "N" men at the time of their graduation, or, in the event that an athlete is not graduated, at the time of the completion of his eligibility.

All medals will have engraved on the back the athlete's name and his complete athletic record while in the university. Each medal will be numbered and a record of the number and the name of the person to whom it was awarded will be kept in the athletic office. This medal will serve as a life pass and will entitle the man to whom it was awarded to admittance to all athletic events on the home grounds of the University of Nebraska.



These medals will be awarded for the first time to the graduating athletes of the class of 1927 and will be awarded at the time of graduation to athletes in the future.

The bronze medal is awarded to a man lettering one year, the silver medal to a man lettering two years, and the gold medal is awarded to each man lettering three years.

CHEERING SECTION



THE RED "N"

Nebraska inaugurated a new system of organized cheering at the football games played this season. This is the first time that a section has been set apart for rooters and the success attending the initial attempt makes for its continuance during coming seasons of the gridiron sport.

Situated on the fifty-yard line, the stunts provided by the special cheering section are visible from all parts of the stadium.

Containing six hundred men students provided with red and white reversible caps, the special section added color and an air of gaiety to the home games of the Cornhuskers. Occupants of the section were also provided with red and white cards and those of the colors of Nebraska's opponents.

Interesting effects were gained by using the colored cards. By holding the cards in a predetermined manner, a white N on a red backfield or a red N on a white backfield could be obtained which covered the



whole section and added much color to the east stands. Opponents of the Cornhuskers in the football sport were also given their share of publicity with cards representing the colors of their schools.

Other effects are planned for next year during the gridiron season. Those in charge found no difficulty in finding occupants for the section, and many desiring the special seats were unable to get them. Emerson Mead had charge of the blue prints for the card arrangements.

Saturday nights from 7 to 11 o'clock are reserved for student roller skating and the teaching of new steps in dancing at the University of Wisconsin.
