Text by Dr. A. L. Lugin Is Now Off Press, Research Describes Sub-science of Geology

Sedimentation in the Mississippi river between Davenport, Iowa, and Cairo, Illinois, is the subject of a book by Dr. A. L. Lugin, instructor in geology, just came off the press this week.

geologists and physiographer, and has bearing on river and flood control which is so much before the public at the present.

Dr. Lugin spent the entire summer of 1925 on the river in a small houseboat in collecting data. The segment of the river covered between Davenport and Cairo is 500 miles.

Book Is Fully Illustrated
 The book consists of 104 pages and includes twenty-four page plates two text figures, and thirty-three tables of mechanical analysis of river sediments. It will be used as a reference in means and methods of studying modern sediments. It is a contribution both of data and interpretation of materials to the science of sedimentation.
 Recently Dr. Lugin had an article

on undertow in the Iowa Academy of Science. The purpose of this report was to state very briefly some observations made on undertow along the banks of the Mississippi river, where the current was negligible and the waves active.
