His early education was received at Humphrey, where he graduated from high school in 1925. The following year he attended Midland college at Fremont.

The Rhodes scholarships were founded by Cecil Rhodes, who amassed a fortune from the South African diamond mines.

Qualifications for Scholar. In order to qualify a candidate must be an American citizen between eighteen and twenty-five years of age, and a resident or college student of two years standing in the state to which he applies.

One From West Point. Schimmelpenninck was the only Rhodes scholar to be chosen this year from West Point.

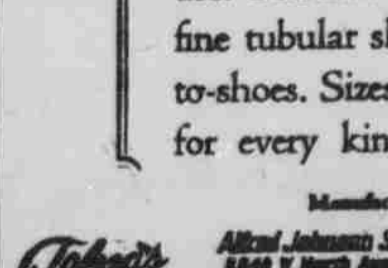
