### HUSKERS ANXIOUS TO BATTLE DARTMOUTH

Possibilities of Contract With Eastern School Interests Fans.

Possibility that Nebraska may meet Dartmouth in football in 1931 has caused a flurry of interest on the Nebraska campus. Pittsburgh is the only eastern team on the 1930 schedule and Cornhusker fans are anxious to see how Nebraska compares with some of the stronger teams in the east.

Athletic Director H. D. Gish disclosed the fact several days ago that Nebraska was negotiating for such an agreement, which would bring Dartmouth to Lincoln in 1931 and send Nebraska to Hanover the following year. Head Coach Bible and E. K. Hall, a prominent alumnus of Dartmouth who also acts on the national rules committee with Bible, have also

been corresponding on the same subject.

The chief difficulty in scheduling games with far eastern teams in the past years has been the unwilling attitude of these teams to sign on a home and home agreement. Numerous teams have been approached and are willing to schedule a game for one year if Nebraska will journey east but are reluctant to give a return game.

Nebraska's attitude in the matter is one of "watchful waiting" and athletic authorities are unwilling to divulge the proceedings until arrangements have been completed. Negotiations have been under way for several months but the contracts have not been finally signed as yet.

A two-year pact between Nebraska and Dartmouth, if entered into, would schedule the 1931 game in Lincoln. The Cornhuskers are dated to perform at Pittsburgh against the Panthers on Thanksgiving of next year, which arrangement would preclude two eastern trips.

### REED GIVES RESULTS OF FRESHMAN EXAMS

Purpose to Place Students in Right Divisions of Algebra, English.

Results of the classification examinations for freshmen students in algebra and English have just been announced by A. A. Reed of

the university extension service. These examinations were given in Nebraska high schools last spring. The written examinations for classification of English students to the correct division of English and classification of engineering students to the correct section of mathematics was inaugurated two years ago. Previous to that time the only means of classification was the amount of English or mathematics the freshman had had in high school. Those students with eight semesters of English in high school were not required to take an examination. The new method, however, requires every freshman student to take the classification quiz.

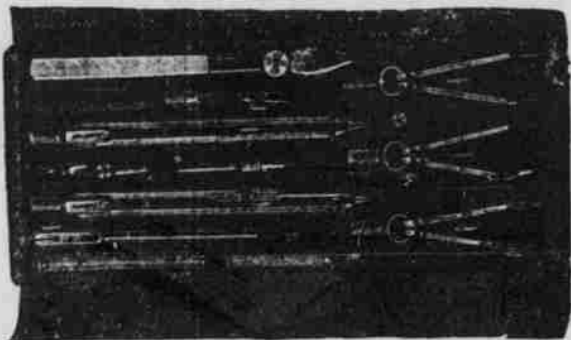

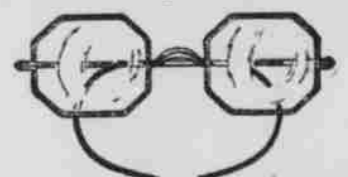
