

### UNIFORMS READY FOR MILITARY STUDENTS

#### Monday Memorandum Lists Instructions for Issuance.

A memorandum providing for the issuance of uniforms to basic men, and sabers and uniforms for advanced drill men, was issued on Monday to all students registered in military science.

Each member of the R. O. T. C. is required to have a uniform, the same to be worn at all military instruction. All articles of the uniform are issued with the exception of the garrison belt and shoes. Each student must provide himself with these items. Shoes will be required when in uniform. They may be either high or low. Boots will be worn by the advanced course students.

Uniforms will be issued from Room 4, Nebraska hall, between the hours 8:30 a. m. to 11:50 a. m. and 1:30 p. m. to 4:50 p. m., except Saturday afternoon and Friday, Sept. 30, which will be devoted exclusively to members of the band.

Each student is required to make a deposit of \$10.00 before his uniform is issued. This deposit is returned at the time the uniform is returned to the storekeeper. Deposits may be made by check or draft. Checks should be made payable to L. E. Groderson.

Members enrolled in the Advanced course as juniors will report for physical examinations and signing of contract before measurements for uniforms will be made.

Seniors in Military Science should obtain their sabres from the storekeeper immediately.

Juniors in Military Science will be issued sabres at the time their uniforms are received from the contractors.
