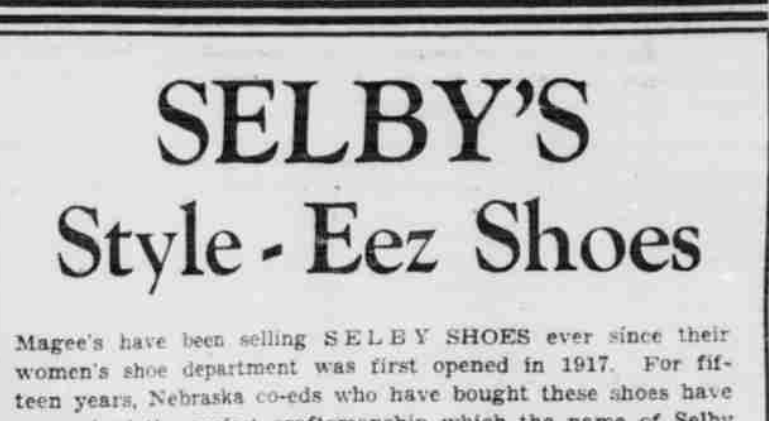
speech will be on a selection of a vocation for girls.

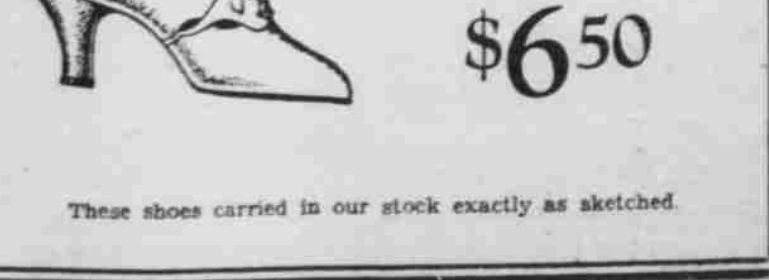
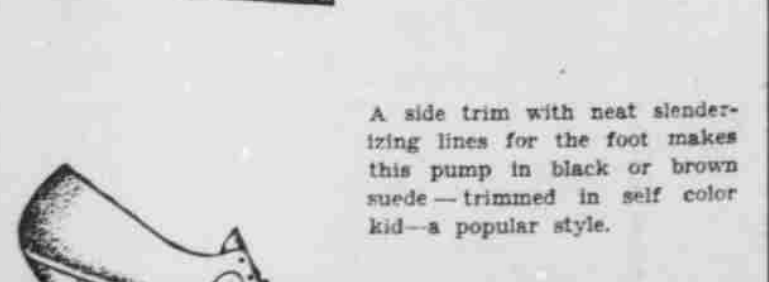
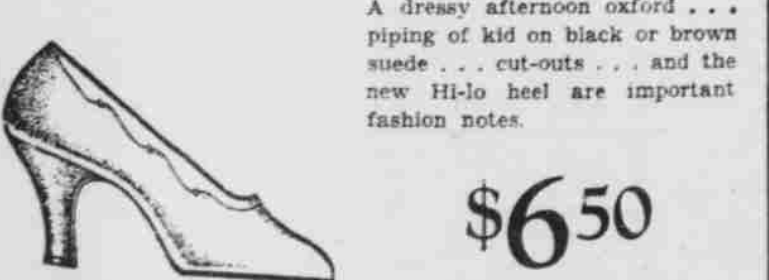
